Re: JOINING INSTRUCTION FOR ACADEMIC YEAR 2021/2022 (SEPTEMBER INTAKE)

BESHA Health Training Institute (BHTI) established in 2012, is fully registered by the National Council of Technical Education. Training programs that are currently offered are **Pharmaceutical Sciences, Medical Laboratory Science** and **Clinical Medicine.**

You are advised to read the following information and instructions very carefully for your orientation.

I. LOCATION OF BESHA HEALTH TRAINING INSTITUTE (BHTI)

BHTI is located in Tanga City, about 3km south of the City Centre and the main Hiace-Bus Stand. It is in Mabawa ward and easily accessible by taxis and town-buses (Hiace or Matatu) going to Donge, Mikanjuni/Magaoni or to Tanga Beach Resort.

II. <u>REPORTING DATE AND REGISTRATION</u>

- You are required to report at BHTI on 10th October, 2021
- For the Registration, you should bring the following documents with you:
 - a) Copy of Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE)/Results slip
 - b) Copy of Birth Certificate
 - c) Two (2) passport size Photographs taken recently.

III. <u>INSTITUTE COSTS</u>

IV, ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

A. Medical Examination

- All students will undergo a mandatory Medical Examination that will be organized by the Institute at the Institution Health Facility (BESHA HEALTH CENTRE) during the orientation and registration period to determine their health fitness.
- Medical examination will be done at BESHA hospital for Tshs 30,000/=. The payment of medical examination should be done on CRDB BANK through account number 0150518908500 Account Name BESHA HEALTH CENTRE.

B. Accommodation

- The Institute has limited hostel facilities and one is advised to book and pay early.
- The Institute provides an empty bed and you should bring your own beddings and a mattress which you may purchase locally from the town.
- All Students are required to sign a contract upon registration.

- Hostellers are advised to bring one bucket for bathing and one basin for cloth washing.
- Cookers, music system, TV set, refrigerators and other electric equipments are strictly prohibited.

C. Uniform guidelines

- Uniform is the student's responsibility and all students admitted to this Institute will be expected to wear full uniform with exceptions to some programs.
- The uniform is according to the Ministry of Health, Community Development, Gender, Elderly and Children recommendations, and every student is required to bring his/her own uniform as follows:
- MALES:
 - > Two pairs of khaki trousers. Students are not allowed to tailor light trousers.
 - ➤ Two white shirts with short sleeves.
 - Black or dark brown shoes
 - Two white clinical coats, one should be long with long sleeves, and the other should be short with short sleeves.
 - ➤ A neck tie corresponding to the colour of the trousers should be put on.
- FEMALES:
 - Two pairs of heavy white dresses with khaki tape on shoulder and with short sleeves. Dresses should be not less than two (2) inches below the knees. Dresses designs should resemble the nurses' uniforms.
 - Two white clinical coats, one should be long with long sleeves, and the other should be short with short sleeves.

• NB:

Each student should maintain a smart attire displaying good attitude.

E: Students of Clinical Medicine should bring the following requirements necessary for their clinical applications:

- > Stethoscope
- > BP machine
- > Personal theatre uniforms (light gown/shirt & trouser
- Clinical (mercury)Thermometer
- Clinical (penlight) torch
- Patella (tendon) hammer
- ➢ Tape measure
- Penlight torch
- Wrist watch/stop watch

NOTE:

- 1. The payment for the end of semester one supplementary, will cost Tshs 30,000/= per module.
- 2. The payment for the end of semester two supplementary, will cost Tshs 130,000/= per module for Medical laboratory sciences and Pharmaceutical Sciences students.
- 3. The payment for the end of semester two supplementary, will cost Tshs 100,000/= per module for Clinical Medicine students.
